How will I be billed?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Customers will receive monthly electric bills from JATON LLC. • You will be billed for PG&E's Regional Renewable Choice Program on your monthly PG&E electricity bill. PG&E's Regional Renewable Choice Program charges and credits will be listed as separate line items and are in addition to your regular electricity charges. The credit will not reflect the charges between you and the developer.
How will my bill be calculated?	Customers will receive a monthly bill from JATON LLC calculated by the amount of energy used (kWh) multiplied by the rate listed in the Customer Developer Agreement (CDA). Customers will be responsible for all applicable federal, state, and local taxes and charges.
How much will enrolling in the program cost?	JATON LLC's residential rate is \$0.080/kWh fixed for 20-years, with a \$6/month subscription fee. Both the rate and subscription fee will be fixed for up to 20-years.
Will my rates change over time?	Customers' normal rates will change based on PG&E's rates, either up or down. PG&E's Regional Renewable Choice rates are based on current California Public Utility Commission approved tariffs. Rates are subject to change annually and as approved by the California Public Utilities Commission.
What is the process for terminating the contract and what is the early termination fee?	The contract can be terminated at any time w/ 30-days written notice. There is no fee to terminate if initial term of contract is completed. There is a \$50 early termination fee if contract is terminated within the first 12-months of the contract. If the Utica Avenue Project's inclusion in PG&E's Green-e Energy certified product is terminated, then JATON will allow customers to cancel without penalty.
What length of agreement/contract is required?	1-year
What other fees might I be charged?	Late charge of 3% for bills that are unpaid for more than 30-calendar days. In addition to your regular electricity charges, customers will be billed for PG&E's Regional Renewable Choice Program on their monthly PG&E electricity bill. PG&E's Regional Renewable Choice Program charges and credits will be listed as separate line items and are in addition to customer's regular electricity charges. The credit will not reflect the charges between customer and JATON.
Program details	<p>JATON LLC is trying to obtain a PPA with Pacific Gas & Electric (PG&E) to have the Utica Avenue Solar Facility Project included in their PG&E Regional Renewable Choice Program. The PG&E Regional Renewable Choice Program is Green-e Energy certified, and meets the environmental and consumer-protection standards set forth by the nonprofit Center for Resource Solutions. Under the California Enhanced Community Renewables program, renewable project developers take on the responsibility for marketing electricity product(s) directly to customers, who would normally receive this type of information from their utility. Green-e Energy provides third-party verification that the end customer receives accurate and sufficient disclosures. Green-e Energy also requires that product disclosures, such as the price that will be billed per unit (kWh or kW) of power and the developer's customer service contact information, be provided to purchasers within 60-days of sign-up in the form of a Welcome Packet. Customers will also receive an annual mailing that includes product information.</p> <p>At this time, a Power Purchase Agreement (PPA) has not been signed w/ PG&E pending sufficient written customer interest and/or commitment to subscribe to the purchase of JATON LLC's solar energy.</p> <p>The Utica Avenue Solar Facility is expected to begin construction in the summer of 2021 and be fully operational by December 2021.</p>
